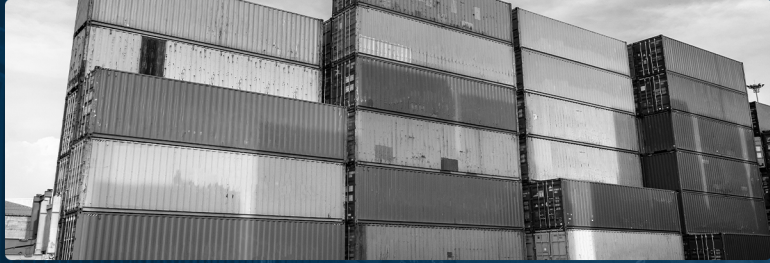

INDUSTRY HIGHLIGHTS



SHIPPING & TRANSPORT EFFICIENCY

Cargo traffic at Philippine ports rose around 11% in early 2025, reflecting strong domestic and international demand. To improve inter-island shipping, the government is implementing infrastructure upgrades and regulatory reforms, including a digital customs single-window and liberalized cabotage rules by 2026. Despite these efforts, domestic shipping rates remain high due to congestion and fragmented transport networks.



COST MANAGEMENT & LOGISTICS SPENDING

Logistics costs in the Philippines remain among the highest in the region, sometimes accounting for up to 27% of retail prices. The Department of Trade and Industry is actively working to reduce this share toward 15% through digitalization, infrastructure investment, and fee reforms. High costs are driven by port limitations, traffic congestion, and gaps in modal integration, which continue to affect warehousing, fuel, and overall supply chain efficiency.



DIGITALIZATION AND AUTOMATION

Sustainability is becoming key in Philippine logistics, with providers adopting electric vehicle fleets, renewable-powered warehouses, and eco-friendly packaging. These measures reduce costs while appealing to environmentally conscious consumers. By 2026, green logistics is expected to be an integral part of supply-chain strategy, driven by regulations, climate risk mitigation, and global sustainability expectations.
